


Salaries

You want to make sure your message makes it to the people who matter, and salaries are a great way to discern who calls the shots. For instance, a Legislative Assistant in the House is typically a more junior staffer with minimal personal influence, while a staffer in the Senate with the same title might well play an important role in shaping a Member's policy perspectives.
