Appendix Response to Item 10

Item 10: Will the activities on behalf of the above foreign principal include political activities as defined in Section 1(o) of the Act. If yes, describe all such political activities indicating, among other things, the relations, interests or policies to be influenced together with the means to be employed to achieve this purpose. The response must include, but not be limited to, activities involving lobbying, promotion, perception management, public relations, economic development, and preparation and dissemination of informational materials.

In order to increase the monetary and in-kind support devoted by the US Government to the defense of Ukraine against the Russian invasion, Registrant intends to lobby members of the US Government to increase US Department of Defense spending on contracts related to equipment and other efforts which will aid the ability of the Ukrainian military to succeed in its fight against the Russian military. Registrant will bolster these lobbying efforts by creating and disseminating informational materials (or by disseminating informational materials created by others in, or affiliated with, the Ukrainian Government) about the war in Ukraine and the ways that spending by the US Department of Defense can support specific objectives of the Ukrainian military. The purpose of this dissemination of information is to both (i) directly influence Defense Department decision-makers and other US policy-makers, and (ii) indirectly influence said decision- and policy-makers by managing the perception of the US public/constituency as it relates to the positive public relations and sympathetic media coverage surrounding the ongoing military defense of Ukraine.
